Want to be Cited More?

Are you a faculty member who is seeking greater awareness of your work? Would you like to increase the availability of your work in a way that could double or triple the number of citations your work receives? Have you given thought to how digital copies of your work will be handled to make sure that it is available twenty, forty, sixty, or more years from now? Are there non-published materials – such as conference presentations or poster sessions – that you would like to make available to a wider audience?

If the answer to any of these questions is yes, you will be happy to know that **Atkins Library is launching its e-Scholar@UNC Charlotte this Fall**. This powerful electronic storehouse will serve as a central point for accessing and preservation of faculty research documents with the goal of providing increased awareness of your research. In the process, the system will provide a myriad of advantages:

- Provide for safe storage and long-term preservation of your work.
- Establish a flexible model to provide maximum access to your research work, while maintaining appropriate copyright and intellectual property protections.
- Work with existing information repositories on campus - such as EPrint archives - to provide access to those resources from within the e-Scholar site.
- Provide links to your research work to Google Scholar, OAI repositories and other web-based information aggregators to include your research in their search engines. Studies have

shown that doing so can increase citation levels up to 300%.

Establish a permanent URL for researchers and others to use in their publications.

How the Economy is Affecting Atkins Library

In these tough financial times, many institutions are forced to make hard decisions about budget issues. Atkins Library has not been immune to these problems.

The receipt of books through the Approval Plan, which includes University Press publications for nearly all subjects, has been suspended.

In addition, it is highly unlikely that we will be able to purchase many new books (including Choice cards selections) in fiscal year 2009/2010.

Faculty can continue to make selections using Choice cards but these will be held until monies are available. In addition, to address some of the budget shortfalls, the library will no longer bind current periodicals. Thesis and dissertations continue to be bound since students pay for this service.

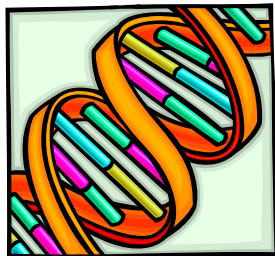
There is some good news. The library intends to maintain most of our electronic databases, which consist of over 250 databases with millions of full text articles.

How to speed-up Interlibrary Loan Requests

Although Atkins Library offers a wide range of electronic and print journals, occasionally you might need an article from a journal to which we don't have access. At these times please try our FREE Interlibrary Loan service, which often can deliver PDFs of journal articles to your email account .

The ILL process goes smoothly if Requesters understand the following limitations:

1. ILL cannot get articles that have been published in the past month
2. ILL cannot get articles from journals that are only published in an online format.
3. Try a Google search for the article before submitting an ILL request. Many articles are available full text on the web.
4. When searching for an article in our catalog search by journal title not by article title – patrons sometimes forget this when they change from the electronic database searching to the catalog.
5. Diacritics in Foreign language titles do not transfer correctly so we just get gibberish. This can make deciphering the title very difficult at times and can lead to requesting the wrong title. Patrons should take diacritics out of the journal title or book title to avoid confusion.
6. ILL should not be used for textbooks or anything that would require a long term loan. We have difficulties with grad. students thinking that they can keep books for the whole semester.
7. The journal title search in the article database does not search the regular catalog. It searches a list of ISSN's that have been added to article database. This often results in the patrons being told that their search was unsuccessful. They are also told to search the catalog but very few do. Instead they think that that the catalog has been searched and go straight to ILL. If they had done a catalog search they would have found that we own what they were looking for.
8. Patrons must submit a full journal title. ILL must cancel requests that submit abbreviated titles.

This gives a basic introduction to various areas in sections titled: Bioinformatics, Genome Mapping, Molecular Modeling, Microarray Technology, Molecular Genetics, etc. "A Science Primer" would be

helpful to anyone not familiar with these areas of study and to scholars who are going to use the NCBI data sets.

NBII-Digital Image Library

The goal of the "Digital Image Library" is to provide a diverse range of high-quality biological images for a wide audience. DIL currently has more than 11,000 images. They are organized by categories including Animals, Fungi and Lichens, Plants, Microorganisms, Environmental Topics, and Landscapes and Weather, with further subcategories in each section. For example, the Environmental Topics section has subcategories such as 'Humans and the Environment,' 'Fire,' and 'Invasive Species.' This is an excellent resource for obtaining a wide range of beautiful nature-related images.

USGS: Biological Resource Discipline

Operates cooperatively across federal, state, and private sectors and serves as a resource. Whether describing white-nose syndrome in bats or mercury levels in bird embryos, this site presents the biological complexity identified on lands stewarded by the Dept. of the Interior.

Ecological Internet

This portal includes a group of separate appropriately named sites, each focusing on a different issue. They included "EcoEarth Info", "Climate Ark", "Forest Protection Portal", "Water Conserve", "Rainforest Portal", and "Ocean Conserve."

Internet Bird Collection

Sponsored by the "Handbook of the Birds of the World", the IBC is an online video library of the world's birds. This site contains more than 28,000 videos representing 5,500 species, with video submissions from almost 200 contributors ranging from professional to amateurs in over 30 countries. Browsing is hierarchical and starts with orders and then families. After selecting a family, users see a list of individual species. Each species includes the number of videos, photos, and sounds available, along with conservation status.

Plant Evolution Timeline

This is a shortened version of a tool used in teaching plant evolution at the Univ. of Cambridge. When clicking on a geologic era or period, the site also displays an illustration of the continental positions at that time. This is a useful Web site for presenting integrated data to students on evolutionary change through time, and is an excellent instructional resource for teachers of undergraduates.

Freshwater Ecoregions of the World

Users can select an ecoregion from the map, browse a list of ecoregions, or search for an ecoregion. For each region, the site provides detailed, factual information including geographic boundaries, species found in the area, habitats, and climate. This resource is valuable for anyone needing to keep up with what is happening to freshwater habitats on Earth.

Plant Information Online

This is a collection of databases, with an emphasis on cultivated plants and plant seed sources. Its unique strength is the detailed indexing of plant images and information from some 600 books and magazines. The newest section of this site, is "Selected Links to Plant Info and Images." Expert Univ. of Minn. Libraries searchers locate and create links for freely accessible images and text, saving users the tedious task of sorting through Web sites.

Nanowerk

This site is a very comprehensive and educational nanotechnology/nanoscience portal. The well-organized home page has sections titled Databases, News, Nanobusiness, Resources, and Introduction to Nanotechnology. A free, searchable Nanomaterial Database provides information on more than 1,900 materials, and a Company and Labs Directory Offers more than 3,000 links. Also available are a conference calendar, video library, free industry reports, periodical directory, and book lists linked to Amazon.com. The site also offers a spotlight feature article, an encyclopedia, blogs, quizzes, career center, and a Nanotalk Community forum.
